Desired Infrastructure of a study centre for offering this course will be:

Space Requirement:

One room for conducting practical work and one room for conducting theory classes. The rooms for conducting theory and practical work should be at least 400 square feet. The institution should have sufficient space for conducting theory as well as practical examinations.

The Practical lab should be well lighted and ventilated. They may have enough open space/verandah for drying of the clay products. There should be ample storage space for raw material and also for storage as well as display of the finished products. The practical lab should have water drainage as well as running water/water storage facilities.

The institution is required to have either its own nursery section/play school or linkage with nursery schools/pay schools for conducting the practical activities related to Joyful learning through toys.
