Step-I Collect information about M.S. Dhoni

You may include:

- (iii) his education, interests and inspiring personality
- (iv) his entry into the field of cricket
- (v) his career as a cricketer
- (vi) his achievements, awards, honours
- (vii) his personal life

Step-II : Select the important information to be included in the sketch. Select important points which will motivate and inspire sports persons to take up the game.

Step-IV : Write a bio-sketch based on your information.
