The attention of the (Inspecting Officers is invited to the Director's Proceedings cited. Instructions were issued from this office after reiterating that no student from other State/Country should be admitted without getting the certificates evaluated by the department. But it is brought to the notice of the Director that some schools admit the students even without the result slips/report card and then send the proposals to the 'Director' for evaluation. This is highly irregular. Specific instructions have already been issued in the Director's Proceedings 2nd cited pointing out the various irregularities committed by the Inspecting Officers in regard to admission of Foreign and Other Statestudents. The certificates of the foreign students should be evaluated only after perusing the Passport and the student Visa.

The general orders issued for admission of Sri Lankan students in Tamil Nadu schools were kept inabeyance and there was a ban in admitting the students for two years. The ban was lifted during the year 1993 and Government orders are assued for each year superseding the orders already in existeence. Hence no Sri Lankan student should be admitted this year1995-96 pendingreceipt of Government orders.

Regarding Other States/Countries a list of their system of education is enclosed for guidance ineval@600 the certificates for admission in schools in Tamil Nadu. The Inspecting Officers under no circumstances should issued any instructions to the schools superseding the Director's instructions in this regard. Any deviation in this regard will be viewed seriously and action taken against the Inspecting Officers.

The Inspector of Matriculation Schools, Madras, Madurai, Coimbatore are specifically instructed to bring this to the notice of the Heads of the respective Matriculation, schools the above instructions and also the instructions issued from time to time from this office.
