- Q. Name the battles fought by Babur in India in their chronological order.
- Q. Rana Sanga decided to wage war against the Mughal invader. Discuss the reason behind Rana Sanga's decision and the battle fought between him and Babur.
- Q. Describe the significance of Rana Sanga in nurturing the view of the Rajputs as a valiant warrior in India.
- Q. The Rajputs had surrounded Babur, but his technically superior army won the battle. Discuss the reason behind Babur's success.
- Q. Differentiate between the military tactics used by Babur and Rajputs in India at that time.
- Q. After the Battle of Chanderi, no Rajput ruler ever challenged the authority of Babur.

Q. Discuss the role of Babur in laying solid foundation of Mughal rule in India. How was Babur different from other Muslim rulers who invaded India.

Q. Babur's artillery had won the day for him; he had finally established the Mughal rule over India and eventually sealed the fate of the Rajput revival. Analyse the above statement with reference to the battle fought by Babur and establishment of Mughal rule in India.
