As National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET) examination is due to take place on 06.05.2018, it is directed that admit cards will be issued to the candidates who have been disqualified on the ground of over age and on account of having studied in the open school and meet the other eligibility criteria. They will be allowed to appear in the examination. However, result of candidates who have been issued admit cards pursuant to interim order passed by this Court would not be declared without leave of the Court. This interim order/direction would not create any equity or any legal right. This interim order would abide by the judgment.
