#### **CIRCULAR**

Subject: Observance of "Vigilance Awareness Week-2022"

Central Vigilance Commission vide its Circular no. 20/09/22 dated 08th September, 2022 has stated that to fight corruption and to exercise general superintendence over vigilance administration, Vigilance Awareness week is to be observed every year during the week in which the birthday of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel (31st October) falls in. The commission has decided that this year Vigilance Awareness Week would be observed from 31st October, 2022 to 6th November, 2022 with the theme "महाचार मुक्त मारत – विकसित मारत" "Corruption free India for a developed Nation". In pursuance of the CVC's Circular, NIOS would be observing "Vigilance Awareness Week" with the Integrity Pledge (Copy enclosed at Annexure-A) by all officers/officials on 31st October, 2022 at 1100 hrs.

CVC has advised to conduct activities relevant to the theme that strives to bring about maximum public participation. All organization should conduct different outreach programme that aim to sensitize the public about the need for transparency and integrity in public governance.

Further, CVC has intimated that in a move towards inculcating the true spirit of participative vigilance, the commission had earlier issued instructions details, a three month campaign period (16th August, 2022 till 15th November, 2022) in which six different preventive vigilance measures were to be taken up as focus areas by all organizations. The different Preventive Vigilance cum internal housekeeping activities are to be taken up as focal areas by all the Ministries /Departments /organization includes the following:

- a) Property Management
- b) Management of Assets
- c) Record Management
- d) Technological Initiatives comprising two parameters
- -Website maintenance & updation
- -Identification of new areas for service delivery focus customers /staff to be brought on online portal an intuition of steps for creating online platforms.
- e) Updation of guidelines /circulars /manuals wherever found necessary and
- i) Disposal of complaints outstanding as of 15/08/2022

The works undertaken on each of these parameters should be submitted as per format by  $9^{th}$  December, 2022 [Format 1(A-F)]

During the observance of Vigilance Awareness Week-2022, CVC has desired following activities to be conducted within the organizations:

a. Employees may be encouraged to take e-pledge by visiting the website. Online "Integrity Pledge" is available at CVC's website (https://www.cvc.gov.in) and can be accessed by all.

b. Conduct workshops/sensitization programs for employees and other stake holders on policies/procedures of the organization and on Preventive

Vigilance measures.

c. Vigilance study Circles may conduct different outreach and awareness programs.

d. Conduct various competitions such as debates, quiz etc for the employees

and their families on issues relating to anti-corruption.

e. Promote the concept of e-Integrity Pledge by persons with whom the organization deals with.

In pursuance of the CVC's Circular dated 08.09.2022, "Vigilance Awareness Week" will be observed at NIOS Headquarters and Regional Centres from 31st October to 6th November, 2022 and pledge shall be taken on 31st October, 2022 at 11:00 AM. Please ensure that all staff members may take e-pledge by visiting the website. Online "Integrity Pledge" is available at CVC's website (https://www.cvc.gov.in).

A copy of CVC's Circular is enclosed alongwith annexure(s). All Departments and Regional Centres are requested to prepare a report on concerned points of the Format 1 (A-E) and Format -2 and submit it to Vigilance Cell on or before 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2022.
